

Changes Are Coming...Are You Ready?

SNAP Emergency Allotments, which are the increased SNAP benefits approved by the U.S Federal Government and issued since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic in March 2020, are ending with the last SNAP emergency allotment issued to customers in February 2023.

Beginning in March 2023, customers will only receive their standard SNAP benefit. Customers will no longer receive the additional emergency allotment that came at the end of the month.
